MEDICAL SERVICES

Clínica de Familia continues to consolidate itself as a leading provider of high-quality healthcare, thanks to a highly trained, multidisciplinary clinical team committed to the well-being of our clients. This year, we expanded our medical specialties to include otolaryngology, neurology, and pediatric nutrition, reinforcing our commitment to comprehensive community healthcare. In addition to these new specialties, we maintain a strong track record of outpatient specialized consultations in areas such as orthopedics, pulmonology, pediatric and adult infectious diseases, psychiatry, urology, cardiology, diabetes care, clinical and cosmetic dermatology, gynecology, family medicine, internal medicine, nephrology, clinical nutrition, pediatrics, perinatology, gynecological endocrinology, geriatrics, and family planning, among others.

Clínica de Familia also has a clinical laboratory certified with the international ISO 9001 quality standard, ensuring high-quality diagnostic testing. Additionally, we offer a full range of diagnostic imaging services, including ultrasound, Doppler, X-rays, echocardiograms, electrocardiograms, Holter and ambulatory blood pressure monitoring (MAPA), and ultrasound-guided biopsies.

HIV PROGRAM

Our commitment is to provide comprehensive care to people living with HIV, including antiretroviral therapy and clinical follow-up, ensuring a client-centered approach. We also offer mental health services through individual therapy, family therapy, and support groups, recognizing the importance of emotional support in healthcare.

This summer, our Camp Hope and Joy held two recreational activities, providing moments of fun and contributing to the emotional well-being of 45 children and adolescents with HIV.

We are also actively involved in HIV prevention through a team of health promoters and various initiatives, such as Undetectable = Untransmittable (U=U), prevention of mother-to-child transmission program, and the provision of pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP), reaffirming our commitment to reducing new infections and ensuring equitable access to healthcare.

Healthcare at Clínica de Familia La Romana is complemented by a strong mental health, social work, and community outreach team, ensuring a comprehensive approach to client care.

Our clinical psychologists offer consultations both at the clinic and in the community and facilitate support groups to strengthen the mental health of our clients. In 2024, we began providing telemedicine mental health consultations and added child development evaluation consultations.

Community health promoters and social workers conduct home visits and provide support to ensure that people with HIV and their families receive the medical and emotional care they need.

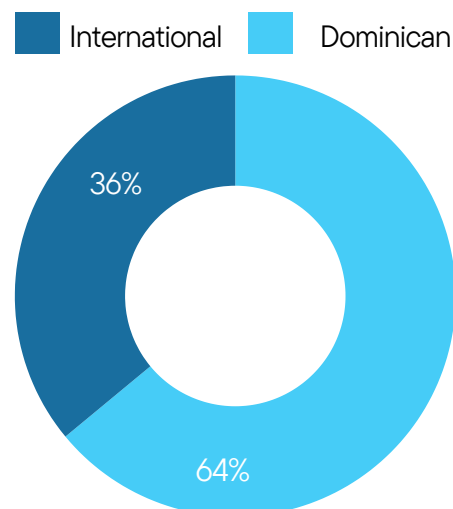
Our Social Work Department provides assistance to vulnerable clients through nutritional support, community gardens, medications, transportation, school supplies, access to subsidized medical services, and improvements to living conditions.

Health promoters also work within the community educating and orienting people from key populations such as sex workers, men who have sex with men, and transgender individuals, facilitating their access to medical services and promoting their overall well-being.

RESEARCH & EDUCATION

Our Research Department published five articles in international scientific journals in 2024 covering topics such as the impact of mobile apps on the health of people with HIV, the effects of violence on adolescents, and gender perceptions among teenage boys. We participated in a Dominican symposium on advances in collaborative research and two international conferences in the United States.

Clínica de Familia welcomed 50 students from medicine, nursing, psychology, business, family medicine residency, laboratory, ultrasound, and radiology technology programs from both Dominican and international universities, who participated in global and community health rotations and public health research projects.

In 2024, our Adolescent Program provided sexual and reproductive health education in six schools, several bateyes (communities of sugarcane workers), and at special community events. We also carried out educational campaigns over social media, peer educator training, and Project AIM, an intervention designed to reduce risky behaviors among adolescents.

GROUNDBREAKING & 25TH ANNIVERSARY



In October, Clínica de Familia La Romana celebrated its 25th anniversary with the groundbreaking ceremony for its new facilities, a project that will significantly expand healthcare services in the community. The event highlighted the clinic's impact and the promising future that this new project represents. As shown above, from left to right, Ana Jiménez-Bautista, Hilda Peguero, and Mina Halpern Lozada (representatives of Clínica de Familia), Danielle Scott (Pincus Family Foundation), Eduardo Kery Metivier (Mayor of La Romana), and Stephen W. The celebration included a commemorative video, marking the beginning of a new chapter for the clinic and its mission to improve healthcare in La Romana.

Over the past decade, Clínica de Familia has taken several steps toward becoming a financially sustainable organization. This includes diversifying its funding sources. A cornerstone of Clínica de Familia's sustainability plan for the next ten years is the construction of a new building to expand its capacity and service offerings, generating additional revenue. This will enable Clínica de Familia to become a self-sufficient organization and ultimately reduce its reliance on grants and donations in the future.

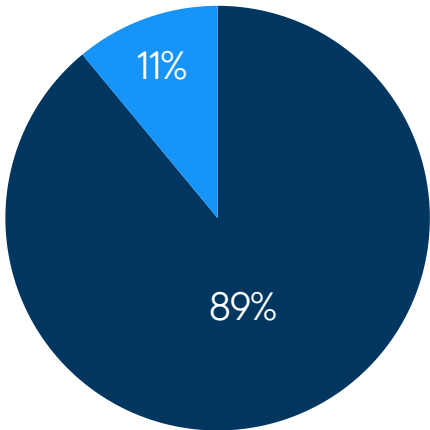
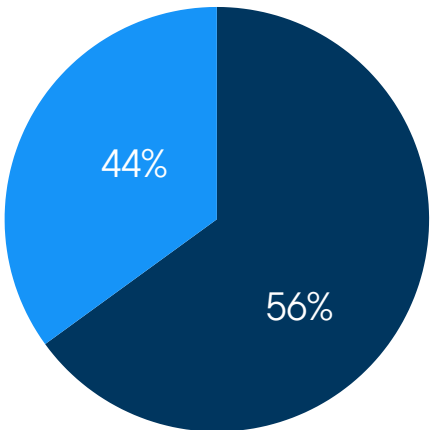
